My dear Sir,

I recieved with a lively satisfaction the letter that you took the trouble to write me the 14th of last May. I thank you much for the interest that you, as well as some other Citizens of Boston have taken to encourage the emigration to Hayti of five coloured ^{men} who have all arrived in this port in the Brig William, Captain Nowell and with whom you have had the complaisance to make an arrangement with them in my name to fix their residence, & work at half profits of the produce for me on my plantations of Coffee. I have paid to Messieurs Hacentjens & Co. consignees of the Brig William one hundred dollars for the passage of these five men according to the receipt of these gentlemen on the
